Term tickets

Term tickets are available for each school term.

Tickets are for the sole use of the named ticket holder for one journey to and from Charters School.

Lost tickets can be replaced. There is a charge to replace tickets - currently £15.

Multi-journey tickets

Multi-journey tickets are available to Sixth Form students on routes 23, 26 & 27. These can be used for 10 single journeys either to or from school.

Sixth Form students can purchase these tickets from the driver on the bus. Payment is by cash or contactless.

Tickets are for the sole use of the ticket holder on routes 23, 26 & 27.

Please note term tickets and multi-journey tickets are valid for use on these buses only. Tickets must be shown to the driver when getting on the bus, and need to be available for inspection throughout the journey. If a ticket cannot be shown, then travel can be refused.

We do not tolerate misuse of any ticket. For example, if a ticket is used by any other person, then the ticket will be forfeited, and both the ticket holder and the person using it may be liable to prosecution.
