Tickets are for the sole use of the named ticket holder for one journey to and from Charters School.

Lost tickets can be replaced. There is a charge to replace tickets - currently £15.

Please note term tickets are valid for use on these routes only. Tickets must be shown to the driver when getting on the bus, and need to be available for inspection throughout the journey. If a ticket cannot be shown, then travel can be refused.
